- <u>IBC Updates:</u> IBC/ICC/IMC (International Building Code, International Code Council, International Mechanical Code) will be updated to 2021 Edition. DSPS edits complete and are being reviewed. Public comment period upcoming. Note: It's expected the 2017 version of ASHRAE 170 will be adopted as part of this process. We are currently on the 2013 version of 170. - <u>DHS Secretary</u>: Former Milwaukee health commissioner Kirsten Johnson has been named Wisconsin DHS Secretary. She will assume the post on Feb. 27, 2023. Karen Timberlake retired effective December 31, 2022 after serving for two years in a designee role.
- <u>Preliminary Project Meetings (PPM)</u>: Department continues to promote PPM's. Emphasis is to review the project scope, schedule, and unique design features.

Facilities need to plan how they will convert permanently or close their Interim Provisions to meet Physical Environment (WI Commercial Building Code, Life Safety code, and DHS 124 / DHS 132, etc.).
