

Code Committee Update – February 2024

New Topic(s):

• DHS 75 Community Substance Use facilities now fall under the plan review authority of DHS. Mutual Agreement between DSPS and DHS was formally signed on January 2, 2024.

## On Going Topics – updates in Bold:

- <u>WI Plumbing Code</u>: New Plumbing Code in effect. The updates to Wisconsin 2009 Plumbing Code took effect on October 1. For a presentation of the changes, see December 2023 update. In summary, the new code addresses Healthcare Definitions, Water Quality, Water Management Plans and applies to new construction and renovations. <u>Not retroactive</u>. Thanks to Tony Ramos, Day School Instructor PROFESSIONAL PLUMBERS UNION LOCAL 75 for this update.
- Wisconsin Commercial Building Code ICC Updates: Wisconsin State Legislature Joint Committee's in the Senate and Assembly reviewed and objected to the DSPS proposal to adopt the 2021 IBC on September 29, 2023.   - <u>Preliminary Project Meetings (PPM)</u>: Department continues to promote PPM's. Emphasis is to review the project scope, schedule, and unique design features.

- <u>CMS Update</u>: Validation surveys of accrediting organization surveys will begin effective October 1, 2023. CMS will be engaging national contract surveyors to be present during an AO accreditation survey to directly observe and evaluate the survey compliance process.
