• 3/27/2024 DSPS Spring Webinar: Healthcare Plumbing Inspections was the primary topic of interest. Municipalities starting October 1, 2023 having plumbing inspectors are now authorized to perform healthcare plumbing inspections. Prior to October 1, 2023 this function was primarily a DSPS State plumbing responsibility.
